As per Rule 7 of G.O.Ms.No.14 dated 20-02-2010, Higher Education(UE.II) Department regarding Coverage and Applicability of UGC Scales 2006, UGC scales are applicable to University and College Teachers, Librarians, Directors of Physical Education admitted to the privileges of the Universities. The scales shall be applicable to the faculty of all the State funded universities established through State Act and receive Block Grants, Government and Aided Colleges, where UGC Scales of pay 1996 were implemented/Extended. The UGC scales are not applicable to the teachers who were in the scales other than UGC and came into the UGC Scales after 1.1.2006, by option. The non-Teaching cadres like Registrars, Controller of Examinations and Finance Officers etc., in respect of the State funded institutions, should continue to be governed by the existing service conditions and state pay scales as approved by the Universities. These State scales are not applicable to the teachers who are drawing the UGC scales of Pay and occupying these posts on deputation or transfer.

Further, in Memo. No.3630/UE.II/2010-2 dt 07-04-2010 Higher Education(UE.II) Department, the State Government clarified that payment of DA, IIRA and CCA as applicable to Central Government employees as per the Government of India orders is applicable to the teaching staff working in the universities and colleges who are allowed the revised UGC Scales 2006 in the State vide G.O.Ms.No.14 dated 20-01-2010, Higher Education(UE.II) Department, subject to the conditions laid down by the Government of India from time to time.

The Government clarified, vide Appendix-1 to G.O.Ms.No.14 dated 20-02-2010, Higher Education(UE.II) Department (Under the Column "Allowances"), that in respect of all allowances, except DA & HRA, State rules may be adopted. In case of DA & HRA the rates prescribed for the Scales of the Central Government Employees, from time to time, shall be implemented. Under the column "Leave Rules", Earned Leave Note.3, it is specified that Encashment of earned leave shall be allowed to non-vacation members of the teaching staff as applicable to the employees of Central/State Government. In this context, it is brought to notice that teaching staff drawing UGC scales working either in Central Government or State Government are eligible for Earned Leave encashment at the time of retirement or superannuation only.

The university teaching staff is quoting the above rule, viz. "Encashment of earned leave shall be allowed to non-vacation members of the teaching staff as applicable to the employees of Central/State Government" but they are actually drawing Surrender Leave encashment (as per State Government scales) in the name of Encashment of Leave, which is not in order. In Prof Jayasankar Agricultural University, instances have come to the notice of audit that teaching staff comprising University and College Teachers, Librarians, Directors of Physical Education (e.g. Assistant Professor, Associate Professors, Professors, Deans, Heads of Departments, Vice Chancellor) are drawing Surrender Leave Encashment every year by quoting the above rule. Further, there is no authority from the State Government to draw surrender leave by the teaching staff drawing UGC Scales.

In this connection, it is requested that clarification is required whether the teaching staff drawing UGC/AICTE scales working in the State Universities are eligible to draw surrender leave encashment entitled under State Government Pay Scales.
